What are Cookies?

Cookies are small data files that websites send to your computer, where they are stored in your web browser. These files do not carry viruses or malware; they remain static and do not affect your computer's performance. Instead, cookies act as records, tracking user activity and storing relevant information that updates each time you revisit a site.

Our website may collect information about you through cookies. Different types of cookies serve distinct purposes. For example, session cookies remain active only while you browse and are automatically deleted when you leave the website.

For this policy, money laundering refers to any activity designed to conceal or misrepresent the origins of illegally obtained money, making it appear as though it comes from legitimate sources or constitutes lawful assets.

Why are cookies useful?



We use functional cookies to analyze how visitors interact with our website, allowing us to monitor and improve its performance and functionality. By quickly identifying and addressing issues, we enhance the overall user experience. These cookies help us determine which pages are most popular, assess the effectiveness of different navigation methods, and track referrals from external websites to optimize our future advertising campaigns.

Cookies also play a crucial role in storing login sessions. For example, when you log into the Members Area to deposit funds, a "session cookie" is created. This cookie enables the website to recognize that you are logged in, eliminating the need to reenter your credentials on every new page during the funding process. Without this cookie, you would be required to input your login details repeatedly while navigating the site.

Additionally, functional cookies help remember your preferences and identify you as a user, ensuring secure and efficient platform operation. For instance, they prevent the need to enter your username each time you access our trading platform and retain your preferred settings, such as your chosen language.

Functional cookies serve various purposes, including:

- Verifying your identity and detecting your location
- Recognizing your browser type and device
- Tracking the website that referred you
- Allowing third parties to personalize content based on your preferences

This website utilizes Google Analytics, a service that Google, Inc. provides to collect and analyze user interactions. Google Analytics employs cookies to gather information, including your IP address, which is then transmitted to Google's servers for processing. This data helps generate reports on website activity, understand user behavior, and provide additional analytical services.
